I Corinthians 10:15-22

Two Important Warnings from Last Weekend...

<u>1 Corinthians 10:12</u> Therefore let anyone who thinks that he stands take heed lest he fall."

1 Corinthians 10:14 "Therefore, my beloved, flee from idolatry."

The Important Definition from Last Weekend...

Idol – "A functional substitute savior that we've chosen to rescue us from our own little hell that we've defined for ourselves."

Paul now builds on this warning against idolatry primarily by considering the depth of meaning of the Lord's Table/Communion

A Call to the Spiritually Sensitive Believer...

<u>1 Corinthians 10:15</u> I speak as to sensible people; judge for yourselves what I say.

The Blood & the Bread...

<u>1 Corinthians 10:16-18</u> The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ? ¹⁷Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread. ¹⁸Consider the people of Israel: are not those who eat the sacrifices participants in the altar?

More to Say about Idolatry...

<u>1 Corinthians 10:19-22</u> What do I imply then? That food offered to idols is anything, or that an idol is anything? ²⁰No, I imply that what pagans sacrifice they offer to demons and not to God. I do not want you to be participants with demons. ²¹You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons. You cannot partake of the table of the Lord and the table of demons. ²²Shall we provoke the Lord to jealousy? Are we stronger than he?

- 1. Idolatry is inconsistent in the believer's life.
- 2. Idolatry is demonic
- 3. Idolatry is offensive to the Lord.

Questions as We Consider the Lord's Table...

- 1. Am I a true participant in the blood of Christ?
- 2. Am I a full participant in the body of Christ?
- 3. Is my life inconsistent with the depth of Christ's sacrifice?
- 4. Would my taking of the elements of the Lord's Table today be offensive to the Lord?
