MORALISM: If I improve my behavior, then I will be accepted by others

**MORALISTIC RELIGION:** If I improve my behavior, I will be accepted by God

# 2) The Stature of Colossians

<u>Colossians 1:15</u> He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. <sup>16</sup> For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him. <sup>17</sup>And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

<u>Colossians 1:5</u> ...because of the hope laid up for you in heaven. Of this you have heard before in the word of the truth, the gospel, <sup>6</sup>which has come to you, as indeed in the whole world it is bearing fruit and growing—<u>as it also does among you, since the day you heard it</u> and understood the grace of God in truth.

## 3) The Significance of Colossians

a) Identity -

Colossians 2:6 Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, <sup>7</sup>rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving. <sup>9</sup> For in him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily, <sup>10</sup> and you have been filled in him, who is the head of all rule and authority. <sup>11</sup>In him also you were circumcised with a circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ, <sup>12</sup>having been buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the powerful working of God, who raised him

b) Idolatry -

<u>Colossians 3:5</u> Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is **idolatry**.
