

#5 Christ in You

Colossians 1:24-29

Colossians 1:24 Now I rejoice in my sufferings for your sake, and in my flesh I am filling up what is lacking in Christ's afflictions for the sake of his body, that is, the church, 25 of which I became a minister according to the stewardship from God that was given to me for you, to make the word of God fully known, 26 the mystery hidden for ages and generations but now revealed to his saints. 27 To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. 28 Him we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all wisdom, that we may present everyone mature in Christ. 29 For this I toil, struggling with all his energy that he powerfully works within me.

PREEMINENCE PRINCIPLE #5:

Putting Jesus First means living in hope because Christ is in me.

The Mystery of Christ in You - Three Elements

- 1. The revelation of Jesus Christ INCARNATE Jesus becoming Human
- 2. Jesus now LIVES IN US through the Holy Spirit
- 3. Jesus is the **SOURCE OF HOPE**

An Astounding Thought - Jesus Christ Lives in Me

John 14:16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, ¹⁷even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you... ²⁰In that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you... ^{23"}If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him.

What are some implications of "Christ in me, the Hope of Glory?"

1. Jesus living in me helps me <u>OVERCOME SIN</u> to put Jesus First <u>James 4:7-8</u> submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you...

Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death.

- 2. Jesus living in me helps me <u>LIVE HOLY</u> to put Jesus First <u>Galatians 2:20</u> I have been crucified with Christ... <u>Romans 6: 4-7</u> We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death...
- 3. Jesus living in me helps me <u>OVERCOME GUILT</u> to put Jesus First <u>Romans 8:1</u> There is therefore now <u>no condemnation</u> for those who are in Christ Jesus.

<u>Romans 5:1</u> Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have <u>peace with God</u> through our Lord Jesus Christ.

4. Jesus living in me fills me with a <u>DEEP SENSE OF JOY AND</u> <u>CONFIDENCE</u> to put Jesus First
