

#5 Let God Be God!

BAD NEWS FOR RELIGIOUS HYPOCRITES

Romans 2:1 Therefore you have no excuse, O man, every one of you who judges. For in passing judgment on another you condemn yourself, because you, the judge, practice the very same things. ² We know that the judgment of God rightly falls on those who practice such things. ³ Do you suppose, O man—you who judge those who practice such things and yet do them yourself—that you will escape the judgment of God? ⁴Or do you presume on the riches of his kindness and forbearance and patience, not knowing that God's kindness is meant to lead you to repentance?

⁵ But because of your hard and impenitent heart you are storing up wrath for yourself on the day of wrath when God's righteous judgment will be revealed. ⁶ He will render to each one according to his works: ⁷ to those who by patience in well-doing seek for glory and honor and immortality, he will give eternal life; ⁸ but for those who are self-seeking and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, there will be wrath and fury. ⁹ There will be tribulation and distress for every human being who does evil, the Jew first and also the Greek, ¹⁰ but glory and honor and peace for everyone who does good, the Jew first and also the Greek. ¹¹ For God shows no partiality.

- 1. Self-righteous hypocrites are actually incriminating **THEMSELVES** when they pass judgment on others 2:1
- 2. Don't be fooled into thinking you will somehow be **EXEMPT** from God's future judgment against sin 2:2-3
- 3. Hard-hearted hypocrites who refuse to repent are in deep trouble with God for **ABUSING** His kindness 2:4-5
- 4. God's future judgment of everyone will be completely fair and IMPARTIAL, based on each person's WORKS 2:6-11
