

#9 How Jesus Died for God... and for you!

Romans 3:21-31 (NIV)

THE RIGHTEOUSNESS OF GOD

Romans 3:21 But now a righteousness from God, apart from law, has been made known, to which the Law and the Prophets testify. ²² This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference, ²³ for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, ²⁴ and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. ²⁵ God presented him as a sacrifice of atonement, through faith in his blood. He did this to demonstrate his justice, because in his forbearance he had left the sins committed beforehand unpunished— ²⁶he did it to demonstrate his justice at the present time, so as to be just and the one who justifies those who have faith in Jesus.

²⁷ Where, then, is boasting? It is excluded. On what principle? On that of observing the law? No, but on that of faith. ²⁸ For we maintain that a man is justified by faith apart from observing the law. ²⁹ Is God the God of Jews only? Is he not the God of Gentiles too? Yes, of Gentiles too, ³⁰ since there is only one God, who will justify the circumcised by faith and the uncircumcised through that same faith. ³¹ Do we, then, nullify the law by this faith? Not at all! Rather, we uphold the law.

The Storyline of the Bible...

<u>Creation:</u> All the good that God originally intended for His creation <u>Fall:</u> How things got messed up and what's wrong with humanity <u>Redemption:</u> How God acted in space and time to reverse the whole trajectory of things and win back a people for Himself <u>Restoration:</u> How it's all going to play out in the end, with God making all things new and reclaiming His original intent for all of His creation.

- The theme of Romans 3:21-31: <u>RIGHTEOUSNESS</u>.
- Righteousness: A validating performance record that opens doors, like a **RESUME** or a **TRANSCRIPT**.

What/who has been your righteousness? Your justification?

RIGHTEOUSNESS...

- 1. Comes from **GOD** "a righteousness from God"
- 2. Apart from our Moral **PERFORMANCE** "apart from law"
- 3. Predicted in the **OLD TESTAMENT** "to which the Law and the Prophets testify"
- 4. Obtained Only by **FAITH** "comes through faith in Jesus Christ"
- 5. Offered without **DISCRIMINATION** "to all who believe. There is no difference"
- 6. Given Freely as a **GIFT OF GRACE** "are justified freely by His grace"
- 7. Requiring a **GREAT PRICE** "through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus"
- 8. Vindicating God's **REPUTATION** "He did this to demonstrate His justice…"
