

## **Don't Trip Them Up**

## Romans 14:10-23

- **1.** How do I decide **WHAT** is acceptable for me to participate in?
  - a. Recognize God has **WELCOMED** me into His family (Romans 14:3)
  - **b.** Recognize God (Jesus) is my **MASTER, LORD, AND JUDGE**. He died for me to save me from sin, and now my life is lived for Him (Romans 14:4, 8, 9)
  - c. I must become fully **CONVINCED** in my own mind (Romans 14:5)
    - From His **WORD**
    - Through the help of His **PEOPLE**
    - By the Spirit
  - d. "Will this decision **HONOR** God?" (Romans 14:6)
  - e. "Will I be <u>THANKFUL</u> to God after I make this decision?" (Romans 14:6)
  - **f.** "Have I become persuaded to the point where I believe Jesus would **AGREE**? (Romans 14:14)
- **2.** How do I decide <u>WHEN</u> to participate in those things I have decided are acceptable?
  - a. If I make this decision, will I <u>PURPOSELY</u> be putting a <u>STUMBLING BLOCK</u> or hindrance in the way of another believer who is present here with me? (Romans 14:13)
  - b. If I make this decision, will I <u>UNINTENTIONALLY</u> be putting a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of another believer? "Do I want to be <u>SEEN</u> by other believers, at this place doing what I'm doing?" (1 Corinthians 8:9, 10)

- c. "Is my conscience <u>DOUBTFUL</u> about participating right now?" (Romans 14:23)
- **3.** What should I **REMEMBER** and always be aware of when participating or not participating?
  - a. The strong are not to judge the weak in faith AND the weak in faith are not to judge the strong. (Romans 14:13)
  - Acting on my freedoms may be part of the cause for the <u>SIN</u> and <u>DESTRUCTION</u> of a believer who is "weak in faith" (Romans 14:15, 20)
  - c. The main things we need to focus on... in and for the kingdom of God... where Jesus is King and we are his servants, are:
    (Romans 14:17, 18)
