<u>Matthew 18:15</u> If your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you. If he listens to you, you have won your brother over.

- 1. **CONFLICT** is going to happen!
- 2. When conflict occurs, **YOU GO!**
- 3. Go **DIRECTLY** to the person **INVOLVED**.

<u>James 1:19</u> My dear brothers, take note of this: Everyone should be <u>quick to listen</u>, <u>slow to speak</u>, and <u>slow to become angry</u>...

Six Keys to Unlock the Padlock of Conflict

Key 1: COMMITMENT

<u>1 Peter 3:8</u> Finally, all of you, live in harmony with one another; be sympathetic, love as brothers, be compassionate and humble.

<u>Romans 12:18</u> If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.

Key 2: <u>COMMUNICATION</u>

"I statements" = When you... I feel... Because... I would like...

Key 3: RESPECT

<u>Luke 6:31</u> Do to others as you would have them do to you.

Key 4: HUMILITY

Key 5: HARD WORK

<u>Ephesians 4:1-3</u> As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. ²Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. ³Make *every* effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.

Key 6: PRAYER

<u>Psalm 142:1-5</u> I cry aloud to the LORD; I lift up my voice to the LORD for mercy. ²I pour out my complaint before him; before him I tell my trouble. ³When my spirit grows faint within me, it is you who knows my way. In the path where I walk, men have hidden a snare for me. ⁴Look to my right and see; no one is concerned for me. I have no refuge; no one cares for my life. ⁵I cry to you, O LORD; I say, "You are my refuge, my portion in the land of the living."

4. The goal is always RECONCILATION

- Conflict is inevitable
- Resentment is optional
- Resolution is up to you
